above If you require lots of storage, bespoke fitted furniture may be the way to go. It works especially well under sloping ceilings or in awkwardly shaped rooms where off-the-peg designs are unlikely to suit. This bespoke bathroom is from Woodstock Furniture. A similar design would cost around £20,000.

left Options for large amounts of storage include Neptune's Chichester fitted double-door washstand in Shell, from £1920, which features drawers for make-up and toiletries, with cupboards for towels, cleaning materials and extras – useful if you like to bulk buy. There are various cabinet options so you can configure a model to perfectly fit your room.

right The Butler wall-mounted bathroom cabinet system from Falper consists of configurable columns of shelves, internal drawers and clothes rails, available in two depths (20 and 35cm) which allow you to create an arrangement that will perfectly suit your space as well as storage requirements, from ornaments to towels. Prices start from £2654. >
