Material Characteristics

Glass countertops and glass countertops with integrated sinks are made with extra-clear safety glass through a thermoforming, de-stressing, and cold painting process using water-based paints.

Satin glass countertops are treated with acid etching and surface formatting with nanotechnological, stain-resistant, and anti-fingerprint paints.

Care and Maintenance Instructions

To always keep the surface in the best condition, it is recommended to pay particular attention to the maintenance phases of the artifact.

Recommended:

- Use a soft cotton or microfiber cloth and non-abrasive liquid neutral detergents.
- Use normal glass cleaning products (Vetrol, Glassex, or others).

Not recommended:

- Avoid the use of abrasives and products such as trielina, acetone, and solvents in general.
- Do not use acidic (descalers) or basic (bleach, caustic soda) products.
- Avoid abrasive creams or steel cleaning products.

CAUTION: Absolutely do not use detergents that are acidic or strongly alkaline (ammonia, bleach, soda, etc.), regardless of their concentration and even if diluted, as they tend to attack the material. Avoid rough and abrasive sponges, metallic pads.
